## 10" Square Quilt Top Sewing Instructions

## Twin Quilts 7 X 9 10in squares

- Place squares on a flat surface and make desired design
- Stack 10 " squares making 7 columns across ( 9 sqs down) label each stack ( $1,2,3 \ldots$ or $A, B, C \ldots$ )
- Sew blocks together with $1 / 4$ " seams
- Use a sewing machine not a serger check to make sure you are keeping your pattern.
- Iron seams to one side in each column. Alternate direction of seams to help nestle when sewing columns together.


## Queen Quilts 9 X 9 10in squares

- Place squares on a flat surface and make desired design
- Stack 10" squares making 9 columns across (9 sqs down) label each stack ( $1,2,3 \ldots$ or A,B,C...)
- Sew blocks together with $1 / 4$ " seams
- Use a sewing machine not a serger check to make sure you are keeping your pattern.
- Iron seams to one side in each column. Alternate direction of seams to help nestle when sewing columns together.
