

10" Square Quilt Top Sewing Instructions

Twin Quilts 7 X 9 10in squares

- Place squares on a flat surface and make desired design
- Stack 10" squares making 7 columns across (9 sqs down) label each stack (1,2,3... or A,B,C...)
- Sew blocks together with ¼" seams
- Use a sewing machine **not a serger** check to make sure you are keeping your pattern.
- Iron seams to one side in each column. Alternate direction of seams to help nestle when sewing columns together.

Queen Quilts 9 X 9 10in squares

- Place squares on a flat surface and make desired design
- Stack 10" squares making 9 columns across (9 sqs down) label each stack (1,2,3... or A,B,C...)
- Sew blocks together with ¼" seams
- Use a sewing machine **not a serger** check to make sure you are keeping your pattern.
- Iron seams to one side in each column. Alternate direction of seams to help nestle when sewing columns together.
