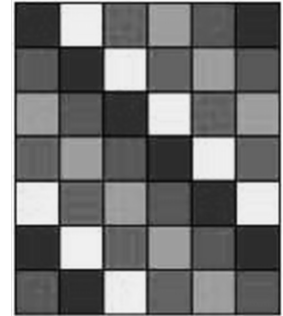


Throw Ten Inch Squares Quilt

Quilt Size: 57" X 66.5"

Fabric Requirements:

- Fabric 1: 1 yard OR (9) 10" squares
- Fabric 2: 3/4 yard OR (8) 10" squares
- Fabric 3: 3/4 yard OR (8) 10" squares
- Fabric 4: 3/4 yard OR (8) 10" squares
- Fabric 5: 1 yard OR (9) 10" squares

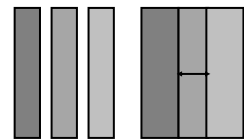


Cutting:

- Fabric 1: (3) 10" X WOF Strips, Sub-Cut: (9) 10" X 10" Squares
- Fabric 2: (2) 10" X WOF Strips, Sub-Cut: (8) 10" X 10" Squares
- Fabric 3: (2) 10" X WOF Strips, Sub-Cut: (8) 10" X 10" Squares
- Fabric 4: (2) 10" X WOF Strips, Sub-Cut: (8) 10" X 10" Squares
- Fabric 5: (3) 10" X WOF Strips, Sub-Cut: (9) 10" X 10" Squares

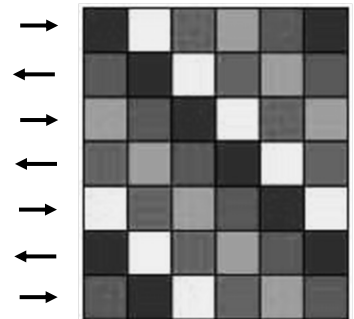
Quilting Tip:

1. Check 1/4" seam accuracy—Sew three 1 1/2" strips of fabric together with a 1/4" seam. Press in one direction. The center strip should measure exactly 1". If the measurement is different adjust as needed. Please do not serge seams. Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all seams.



Assembling the Quilt Top:

1. Layout 10" squares in desired design with 6 blocks across and 7 blocks down.
2. Use a 1/4" seam allowance.
3. Sew the blocks in each row together and press the seams in the direction indicated in the diagram. Press seams to one side, alternating rows to allow seams to nestle together.
4. Then sew rows 1-7 together, matching the seam lines.
